



**TITLE :** Development of Classical Guitar Practice Set for Grade 10 Students  
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### **ABSTRACT**

The purposes of this research are to develop a classic guitar practice set for grade 10 students and the effectiveness ( $E_1/E_2$ ) is set at 80/80, compare learning achievement and classic guitar skill of students before and after learning, and evaluate satisfaction of learners towards the classic guitar practice set. The sample group consists of ten grade 10 students. The tools used in this research are 1) eight learning activities plans; 2) forty items 4-multiple-choice learning test; and 3) twenty items 3-rating-scale satisfaction questionnaire. In addition, the statistics applied in this research are percentage, mean, standard deviation, and Wilcoxon signed rank test.

The findings indicate that:

1. The effectiveness of learning activities with the classic guitar practice set for grade 10 students equals to 80.75/80.25, which conforms to the determined criteria;
2. The learning achievement of students learning with the classic guitar practice set is statistical significance at .01 level, which is higher than pre-learning;
3. The skill of students learning with the classic guitar practice set is statistical significance at .01 level, which is higher than pre-learning;
4. The satisfaction level of students learning with the classic guitar practice set in overall is high ( $\bar{X}=2.81$  ; S.D=0.10).
